## March 22, 2023 House State Affairs Committee Written Testimony <u>FOR HB2843 and HJR 155</u>

Dear Chairman Hunter and members of the House State Affairs Committee,

TAB is the State Chamber of Commerce and the state affiliate for the National Association of Manufacturers. TAB represents members across every industry sector and size, and our local chamber partners across the state. TAB's purpose is to "champion the best business climate in the world, unleashing the power of free enterprise to enhance lives for generations". On behalf of nearly 1,500 business members from across Texas and over 200 chambers of commerce, the Texas Association of Business (TAB) strongly supports HJR 155 and HB2843.

Amending the Texas Constitution and allowing for the creation of destination resorts will usher in a significant amount of economic benefits to the state, including nearly two hundred thousand jobs for construction during the building process as well as the multitude of jobs when the resorts are fully up and running.
